

Attractive opportunities abound in Brunei

BRUNEI DARUSSALAM: Bina Puri Holdings Bhd's subsidiary Bina Puri (B) Sdn Bhd sees attractive opportunities in Brunei on the back of a string of infrastructure, housing, road, airport, highway and port projects to be implemented by the local government, said chairman

Datuk Ali Abdullah.

To date, the Brunei-based construction subsidiary of Main Market-listed Bina Puri Holdings has participated in five tenders of construction and infrastructure jobs worth a total value of B\$160 million (RM383.14), he said.

"For the next three months or six months, we will be anxiously waiting for the result of two tenders," Ali told reporters at a media visit to the group's construction projects here last Friday.

"The projects are quite sizeable in terms of the Malaysian and Bru-

neian economy. We hope we will contribute and help Brunei in its economy growth."

He added that the two tenders are worth a total of B\$74 million. Bina Puri (B)'s unbilled amount of work in the country totalled B\$105 million, which includes the Kam-

pung Lugu development project and redevelopment of Ong Sum Ping apartments.

Other projects secured in Brunei include the pilot scheme for the development of 2,000 houses for the National Housing Scheme of Brunei Darussalam.
