Bina Puri to operate two more power plants in Indonesia

KUALA LUMPUR: Bina Puri Holdings Bhd has been awarded contracts to operate two units of 2-megawatt (MW) power plants in Indonesia through its 80% subsidiary, PT Megapower Makmur.

Bina Puri will operate one power plant in Wilayah Bangka Belitung for three years and the other in Kepulauan Riau

for one year.

The power plants are expected to be operational in July and will contribute a total of RM6.59 million in revenue.

Managing director Tan Sri Tee Hock Seng said the group, whose core business is construction, is tendering for more diesel-generated power plants in

Indonesia.

"We also plan to bid for a hydro plant in Indonesia in the third quarter of this year," he said in a statement.

With the latest contracts, Bina Puri will be operating a total of five units of 2MW power plants in Indonesia. — Bernama
