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Bina Puri launches apartment in Sandakan

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SANDAKAN (July 13, 2012): Bina Puri Construction Sdn Bhd and its joint-venture partners, Syarikat Perumahan Negara Berhad and Puncak Deras Sdn Bhd, today launched Taman Permata Apartment at 12.8Km, Jalan Labuk, here.

The six-storey apartment offers 1,440 units, 35 per cent of the units in the mixed development project have already been sold. Bina Puri Holdings Bhd Chairman Tan Sri Wong Foon Meng said the first phase comprises double-storey terrace houses and shoplots while the apartment units would be built under phase two.

He said the project is considered among one of the largest projects here to cater to the needs and demands of residential property buyers in this east coast of Sabah town.

"Taman Permata Apartment has received encouraging response from potential buyers. I believe after the official launch today, more buyers will be interested to buy the units," he said at the launch by Sandakan Municipal Council President Datuk James Wong.

Located 20 minutes from Sandakan town, Taman Permata Apartment offers two types of built-up areas, 750 square feet and 850 square feet, with selling price starting from RM112,195.

"It's all about accessibility, value for money and high quality finishings. Buyers will enjoy facilities almost similar to a condominium unit although the concept of this project is medium cost," Wong added. – *Bernama*
