CHIEF Justice Tan Sri Arifin Zakaria heads a list of 1,523 recipients bestowed awards and medals in conjunction with the birthday of Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah today.

He is the sole recipient of the Darjah Seri Setia Mahkota Malaysia (SSM), which carries the title "Tun".

Court of Appeal President Tan Sri Md Raus Sharif and Chief of Defence Forces Gen Tan Sri Zulkifeli Mohd Zin were bestowed the Darjah Panglima Mangku Negara (PMN), which carries the title "Tan Sri".

Thirty-nine other people were bestowed the Darjah Panglima Setia Mahkota (PSM), which also carries the title "Tan Sri". They include Federal Court judge Datuk Suriyadi Halim Omar, Malaysia's former permanent representative to the United Nations Datuk Hamidon Ali, Sarawak State Secretary Datuk Amar Mohamad Morshidi Abdul Ghani, Sabah State Secretary Datuk Seri Panglima Sukarti Wakiman, Petronas president and chief executive officer Datuk Shamsul Azhar Abbas and Asian Strategy & Leadership Institute chief executive officer Datuk Dr Michael Yeoh Oon Kheng.

Tuanku Abdul Halim's daughter, Datuk Seri Diraja Tunku Puteri Intan Safinaz, has also been bestowed the PSM.

Chief of Army Gen Datuk Zulkifli Zainal Abidin and Deputy Inspector-General of Police Datuk Seri Khalid Abu Bakar received the PSM.
