

Bina Puri won the Malaysian Construction Industry Excellence Award (MCIEA) 2012

Bina Puri won another award from the Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB) Malaysia under the **Malaysian Construction Industry Excellence Award (MCIEA) 2012 : Category Major Project Awards** (More than RM30 Million) for the Proposed Design, Construct and Complete Mainline Bridge A, Ramp A, Ramp B, Ramp C and Ramp D package of the Proposed Eastern Dispersal Link ("EDL") Johor Bahru, Johor.

The project valued at RM 293.0 million and was completed by Bina Puri Construction Sdn Bhd in December 2011. EDL is a new eastern link at the southern region of Johor that provides shorter travel distance between Johor Bahru and Kota Tinggi.

The award presentation ceremony was held at the Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre on 28th March 2013, presented by The Honourable Chief Secretary to the Government of Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr Ali bin Hamsa. YBhg Tan Sri Datuk Tee Hock Seng, Group Managing Director received the award on behalf of Bina Puri Group.

The Malaysian Construction Industry Excellence Award (MCIEA) is the most awaited recognition merit in the industry, intended to be the Malaysian premier accolades for all round excellence.

For record, this is the 5th award received under MCIEA. Bina Puri has won 4 awards including the MCIEA 2005 Prominent Player Award: Tan Sri Datuk Tee Hock Seng, the MCIEA 2007 Contractor Award Grade G7– Capital Square Condominium, the MCIEA 2008 International Achievement Award-Thailand Project & MCIEA 2011-Brunei Project.
