

The change of Government was truly unexpected and tribute to Malaysians that it was done in a peaceful manner and we trust that we can now move forward and work together as Malaysians for the betterment of all of us.

Jan- June 2018 Performance Review

Two major projects were completed and delivered on time. These projects are the Medini Twin Tower in Iskandar, Johor Bharu and the other being the Bunus Regional Sewage Treatment Plant in Kuala Lumpur. I am thankful to the project teams and smart partners involved for their dedication and commitment towards the completion of these two projects. However, we must continue to strive to work even harder and achieve greater heights as we still have various ongoing projects and at the same time we look forward to secure more of such projects.

Leading up to the 14th GE, the construction and most sectors in more ways than one came to a stand-still. Everyone took a wait and see attitude and were anxious on the outcome of the GE and to how it would affect businesses and industries. Changes are expected, as we are all aware, some of the major projects by the previous Government have been reviewed by the present Government and a few have been cancelled i.e the MRT3 line and the High Speed Rail line between Kuala Lumpur and Singapore whilst some others have been put on hold. Bina Puri was also affected as a few projects we earmarked have now been "on hold" or "cancelled". With these decisions taken, we have to work even harder now to achieve our set targets for growth within the Bina Puri Group.

Our first quarter results for 2018 were encouraging. We almost doubled the profit reported in the corresponding period to RM6.256 million as compared to the

RM3.251 million (Q1 2017). This 92.4% increase is a reflection of our boost in property investment, power supply division, the various successful measures taken thus far in our cost-saving exercise and improvement in project monitoring. However revenue decrease by 40.3% to RM166.571 million (Q1 2018) compared to RM279.033 million due to fewer new projects secured resulting from our thorough selection process of new projects tendering exercise.

The first half of 2018 also witnessed one of our projects receiving international recognition. Congratulations to the 1,000 Houses Project at Kg Lugu National Housing Scheme Phase 1A, Brunei Darussalam on winning the Green Mark Gold Rating at the Building & Construction Authority (BCA) Awards 2018, held at Resorts World Sentosa, Singapore on 22nd May 2018.

The Opus Kuala Lumpur held a Topping Up and Appreciation Ceremony on 5th June 2018. The number of units sold thus far stood at 92% of the total units available. Due to customer awareness of the strategic location area within the same vicinity as the PNB 118 project and market sentiments, the gross development value of this project has increased from its initial RM360 million to RM430 million since its commencement in June 2015. The project is targeted to be completed in December 2018 and I hope the project team can work doubly hard to make it happen without excuses as the original delivery date has been pushed back already.

Kelab Sukan & Social Bina Puri (KSSBP)

At the recently held AGM of the KSSBP, a new and fresh vibrant team was elected to steer the social arm of the organisation. For the term 2018 to 2020, we also had a "returning" President, Mr Lee Tong Leong (previously served for the term 2016 to 2018) as the President. We trust his leadership and new dynamic committee (out of which 50% are new faces) will ensure the club serves our members well

with various fun filled activities throughout their term. Congratulations to Mr Lee and the new committee!!

To the previous committee, my heartfelt thanks to all of you for your tireless efforts and commitments for the various activities throughout the two years. We truly appreciate the many games, social activities and local plus overseas outings that were ever so memorable till today and fresh in our minds. Once again, a big 'Thank You' to all of you.

Moving forward

With the gloomy economy, business outlook and our Group's financial position, Management had undertaken various cost management measures including salary reduction for Directors. We are grateful that some of our Directors have even volunteered and refrain from drawing salaries.

We hope the local economy and construction sector will strive once again and we are sure to those who are willing to work hard, success awaits you. The construction sector will always reward those who work honestly and with integrity. To all our staff of Bina Puri, lead a healthy lifestyle with some form of regular exercise. Be positive in all that you do, be it at home, workplace or within your social circle. 2018年1月 - 6月业绩回顾

在这半年期间,有两个主要项目按时竣工且准时交付。 这两项工程就是位于新山 Iskandar 的Medini双塔,及位于吉隆坡的 Bunus 区域污水处理厂。 这两项工程能够顺利完工,我在此感谢负责此项目的团队及全体合作伙伴所作出的奉献和担当。不过,我们不应该就此自满,应该继续努力以赴,在未来的工程可以自中取得更高的成就,同时我们也期待着能够再接再厉; 能够接手更多这样的项目。

我们在2018年第一季度的业绩令人鼓舞。与2017年第一季度同期的三百二十五万一千令吉(RM3.251 million) 相比,我们同期的業績报告, 其利润几乎翻了一倍,高達六百二十五万六千令吉(RM6.256 million), 共增加了92.4%,卓越

的業績表現反映在房地产投资,电 力供应部门,再加上我們在各工程 領域所採取的节省成本措施以及项 目监控。

的改善等,為我們帶來可觀的利潤增長。然而,由于我们对新项目招标方面採取了更慎重的全面遴选程序,导致得標的新项目减少,与过去的二亿七千九百零三万三千令吉(RM279.033 million)比较,我们整体营业额减少40.3%,2018年第一季度整体营业额为一亿六千六百五十七万一千令吉(RM166.571 million)。

2018年上半年我们其中一个项目获得了辉煌的认证。衷心恭喜汶莱Kg Lugu国家家园1A期的千户屋业计划,于2018年5月22日在新加坡圣淘沙名胜世界举行的2018年建筑管理局(BCA)颁奖典礼上赢得绿色标记黄金评级。

吉隆坡0pus 于2018年6月5日举行了封顶仪式与感恩晚宴。到目前为止所售出的单位占总数92%。由于顾客对 PNB 118 项目的认可与地理环境因素的认识相继提升,该项目的总开发价值从2015年6月刚推出时的三亿六千万令吉(RM360 million)增加到四亿三千万令吉(RM430 million)。该项目预期将于2018年12月完成,我希望负责项目的团队能够加倍努力,不要再推托找借口令计划再度被拖延。






IMPROVEMENT TEAMS TRAINING WORKSHIP
