The Award was presented by Mr. Yoshihiro Yamaguchi, from the Overseas Construction Association of Japan (OCAJI) representing the late Takeo Atsumi, Past President of IFAWPCA, 1973-1974.

The last award recipient for Malaysia was YAB Tun Dr. Mahathir Bin Mohamad during the 29th IFAWPCA Convention in Kuala Lumpur in 1998. Thus it is truly an honour for Tan Sri Datuk Tee Hock Seng to receive this prestigious award.
