MESSAGE FROM GROUP MANAGING DIRECTOR

It seems just like yesterday when we ushered in the year 2018, and now we are already at the dawn of 2019. 2018 was a historic yet difficult year. Closer to home, we witnessed the change in the Government for the first time since our independence in 1957.

There was some positive news in that our property division showed good sales especially during the third quarter of the year, namely for The Opus at Jalan Tallala in Kuala Lumpur, Jesselton View and One Jesselton projects in Kota Kinabalu as well as for The Valley, Karak @ Bentong in Pahang. This was indeed a great achievement which contributed to our revenue of RM526.9 million for the quarterly financial period ended 30 September 2018.

The Group also managed to double the profit before tax to RM20.0 million for the third quarter of 2018 as compared to RM11 million in the previous corresponding period. This is a promising outlook for the Bina Puri Group of Companies.



Bina Puri Holdings Bhd, through its wholly-owned subsidiary, Bina Puri Construction Sdn Bhd on 20th February 2013 entered into a contract agreement with the concessionaire, Pangkalan Ikan Central Sdn Bhd (PIC) to plan, design and build a fishery complex in Kuching, Sarawak, at a contract value of RM247.84 million.

The scope of works included piling works, building works, mechanical & electrical, civil and infrastructure and external works, marina works, landscaping, signage & furniture for the concessionaire. The project commenced on 22nd July 2014 and was successfully completed on 31st March 2017, two months ahead of time.





It involved a total of eight ambulances from St. John Ambulance Malaysia, five medical personnel from the hospitals, four fire rescue trucks and one HAZMAT mobile team.






TRIP TO KOH LIPE, THAILAND




