Bina Puri keen to build the 'last mile'

Firm to submit proposal on final stretch of KL Outer Ring Road

KUALA LUMPUR: Bina Puri Holdings Bhd plans to propose building the last section of the Kuala Lumpur Outer Ring Road (KLORR) project for between RM50 million and RM60 million, says a top executive of the company.

The group is preparing to submit a proposal to the Economic Plan-ning Unit (EPU) soon and it will include a plan on how it will complete the last section of KLORR, stretching from Gombak to Karak, its executive director Matthew Tee told

Business Times.
"We would be keen to submit our papers for consideration. As we have just completed the Kuala Lum-pur-Kuala Selangor Expressway (Latar), it is a logical progression to go for the last piece of the puzzle, he said.

Tee said in building Latar, Bina Puri has established its capability and strengths, enough for the government to consider it for the
