Bina Puri gets RM155mil Russian job

KUALA LUMPUR: Bina Puri Holdings Bhd has secured a contract worth RM155mil from the country's Public Works Department to build a chancery and official ambassador's residence in Moscow, Russia.

In a filing with Bursa Malaysia, Bina Puri said the contract was awarded to the consortium of Bina Puri-Beringin Waja led by Bina Puri Sdn Bhd, a wholly owned subsidiary of the company.

The project is expected to be completed within 36 months.

"The group's current unbuilt book order stands at RM2.06bil as at to date. The contract is expected to contribute positively to the earnings of the Bina Puri group for the financial year ending Dec 31, 2013," it said.

In a separate statement, Bina Puri group managing director Tan Sri Tee Hock Seng said the Malaysian embassy comprised a chancery block, a multi-purpose hall and the ambassador's residence sited in three zones, and takes into consid-

eration the functions and levels of security of each zone.

"The three-storey chancery block designed with a curved elevation is sited at the front to afford easy identification from the main street leading into the complex. Modern in approach to complement the neighbourhood, the Malaysian identity 'Kelarai Bertindih' is reflected on the walls of the chancery block to complete the unique montage. The interiors will also feature Malaysian flavours."
